

## Overnight Program – FAQ

**Q:** Do you have cooking utensils and cutlery that can be used by the group?

**A:** Unfortunately, we do not have many of either and therefore we suggest that you bring your own if you are planning on cooking dinner.

**Q:** What do most groups do for dinner?

**A:** The majority of groups choose to order in pizza from the Pizza Pizza across the road from the Museum. As well there is a wide variety of other fast food restaurants (including Tim Horton's, Pizza Pizza, McDonald's, Subway, and Mr. Sub).

**Q:** Where do we sleep?

**A:** Your group will sleep in one of the Museum's modern buildings. The building will depend on the size of your group and other bookings on site.

**Q:** Are the nap mats comfortable enough for an adult?

**A:** I have slept on them at previous overnights when I had forgotten my own air mattress and they were ok for one night. However, if you do have your own air mattress I would suggest bringing it : )

**Q:** Can we have a real camp fire?

**A:** Yes, we do allow camp fires in our fire pit, but only from May to the end of September. We must be informed **at least 3 weeks** in advance that you would like to have a camp fire as we will need to organise the proper fire permits. Additionally, there is **\$10.00 cost** that for a camp fire that covers the wood and fire permit.

**Q:** Are we alone overnight or does a staff member stay with us?

**A:** A member of the Programming Team always stays overnight on site in the Museums office area. Leaders can reach them via radio or cell phone overnight. Therefore if you require them for any reason they are accessible to you.

**Q:** Do the Museum Programming staff have Police Reference checks?

**A:** Yes, all Museum Programming staff have recent Police Reference checks.

**Q:** Can we get a copy of the Fire Safety Plan for the Museum?

**A:** Yes, we have a copy we can email you which is 74 pages. As well, the plan is posted in all the major buildings on site.

**Q:** Are there bathrooms near where we sleep?

**A:** The bathrooms are located within the same building, but sometimes they are located on another level of the building e.g. up or down one set of stairs.
